brain hemisphere /breɪn ˈhemɪsfɪər/
półkula mózgu

Damage to a **brain hemisphere**, such as from a stroke or traumatic brain injury, can result in specific impairments, such as aphasia or spatial neglect.

multiple sclerosis (MS) /ˌmʌltɪpəl skləˈrəʊsɪs/
stwardnienie rozsiane (SM)

Multiple sclerosis is a condition that affects the central nervous system and is characterized by the progressive damage of the protective covering of nerve fibers known as myelin.

stroke /straʊk/
udar

A **stroke** is a neurological event that can cause hemiplegia, among other symptoms.

epilepsy /ˈepɪlɛpsi/
padaczka

Recurrent seizures or convulsions are the main symptoms of **epilepsy**, a neurological disorder that impacts the central nervous system.

spinal cord /ˌspaɪnəl ˈkɔːd/
rdzeń kręgowy

The **spinal cord** is a long, thin, tubular bundle of nerve tissue that extends from the base of the brain down through the spinal column.
