Abstract

Background: Playing-related musculoskeletal disorders (PRMD) are an often-reported problem in the literature. PRMD are usually defined as pain, numbness, weakness, paresthesia, or other feelings affecting the musician's performance.

Aims: The study aimed to assess the epidemiology of PRMD among violin players in relation to their age, sex, and experience. Additionally, the analysis covered prevention strategies.

EXERCISE 5.

The most popular prevention strategy chosen by the respondents was 1. (rozciąganie) (46%), which was even more common in the case of an 2. (ostrego) PRMD episode (55.5%). Our study did not allow us to assess the efficiency of 3. (profilaktycznych) strategies based on physical activity. Due to the nature of the study 4. (kwestionariusz online), the authors were unable to verify whether the exercises were carried out properly by the study subjects. Cooper et al. [16] claim that 5. (odpowiednio) done stretching exercises (lasting 10 minutes with instructor supervision) 6. (istotnie) minimize the risk of PRMD in string players. The assistance of an experienced trainer allows for avoiding the 7. (niepożądanych) effects of stretching, such as pain, muscle stiffness, or a decrease in muscle strength.


